Information You Provide to Us

We collect personal and other information that you enter into our site or otherwise provide to us. For example, in using the site, making a purchase or communicating with us you may supply us with such information as your name, address, email address, phone numbers and credit card information. The credit card information collected is strictly used for billing purposes.

Information Collected Automatically

We automatically receive and store certain types of information when you use our site. This information may include, among other things, email address, your Internet protocol (IP) address; computer and connection information such as browser type and version, operating system, and platform; purchase history; the full Uniform Resource Locator (URL) clickstream to, through, and from our site, including date and time; and page response times, download errors, length of visits to certain pages, and page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks, and mouse-overs).

Cookies

United Recycling uses cookie technology to increase the ease of use of this site. When you use this site it will send a request to your browser to record information in a “cookie” file. The cookie is a small text file that resides on your hard drive. From time to time, our site will request the cookie from your browser so we can retrieve the stored information and you do not have to repeatedly enter information. United Recycling never uses cookies to store credit card information, nor is the information we store in the cookie intended to be read by any other website.

Many browsers allow users to set the preferences to show a warning each time a cookie request is received. You can also set most browsers not to accept cookies at all.

Security
